VIP LUNCHEON FOR ADULTS 55+: AUGUST 4

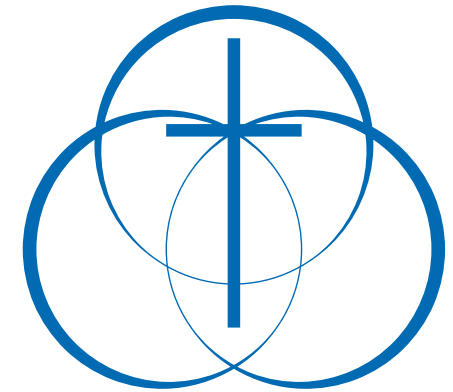
