Madison Missions Spotlight: Western Asia/ Eastern Europe missionaries

Here are updates from missionaries we support in an undisclosed area of Western Asia/Eastern Europe. Their ministry is in a country that is 95% Muslim and many from their underground church face persecution due to their faith.

1. Baptisms

Their team is thrilled to report that 11 Muslim people decided to follow Jesus in 2025! Their team is investing in discipling these new believers. Please continue to pray for them to grow in faith as they face opposition from their families and communities.

2. Coffee House Outreach

Their Coffee House Outreach continues to have a significant impact and provides a port of entry for their team and church members to meet and build relationships with people who do not know the Lord. They had a lovely gathering prior to Christmas with their team.


