CORNERSTONE CELEBRATION



Ten years ago, this congregation embarked on a project to support our growing ministries. An outgrowth of the church's long range planning process, a new education building, the Cornerstone Project, we designed a multipurpose facility that would serve the future needs of children, youth, and adult programs. Since its completion in 2016 we have used this space for countless Sunday School classes, weekday children's ministries, student gatherings, adult bible studies, and churchwide events. The servant spirit of this congregation has allowed us to reach many new people for Christ and develop faithful disciples.

This congregation has a long history of early debt retirement for capital building programs. In May we completed the project with our last payment on the building loan – ten years ahead of schedule! This was made possible by the excellent financial stewardship of our Administrative Council and leadership, Lord's Acre donations, and budget surpluses, which combined to allow us to make extra principal payments along the way. Thanks be to God for His continued blessings and your extraordinary generosity.

We will celebrate this milestone as part of our worship services on Sunday, June 8th. This is

appropriately enough Pentecost Sunday when we celebrate the birthday of the Church through the work of the Holy Spirit. As part of our celebration, we are bringing back a long-standing tradition and providing a lunch prepared by Penn's Fish House! Catfish Fillets, Chicken Tenders, French Fries, Hushpuppies, Baked Beans, and Slaw. There is no charge for you, or your family, and members and guests alike are invited. 
