Adults	Course Description
1001 Empty Nest – Open Heart	invites women into a season of renewal, purpose, and intentional living after their children leave home. Rather than viewing this transition as a loss, this session reframes it as a sacred opportunity to realign priorities by deepening one's walk with God and discerning His call for the next chapter. Participants will explore refocusing on marriage by nurturing connection, friendship, and shared vision, while also being encouraged to grow spiritually, intellectually, and practically through new skills, long-held interests, and fresh callings. This session inspires women to reinvest in themselves with confidence and faith, embracing renewed identity and joyful expectation for what God still has ahead.
1002 Single, Saved, and Satisfied with Standards	speaks to women who are confidently embracing singleness while remaining grounded in faith and values. This session encourages women to prioritize God, live with purpose, and pursue spiritual growth without compromise. Attendees will be challenged to uphold high, biblically rooted standards that honor their identity as virtuous women in relationships, choices, and daily life. Rather than waiting for a future season, this session affirms that fulfillment, joy, and identity are found in Christ alone, empowering women to walk boldly in obedience, contentment, and integrity while trusting God's timing and plan.
1003 Women Warriors	is a bold call for Christian women to rise with courage, faith, and spiritual strength. This session focuses on overcoming fear and anxiety by trusting God fully and walking confidently in His promises. Women will be encouraged to face past pain with grace, choosing forgiveness and healing so yesterday's experiences no longer limit tomorrow's purpose. Through faith-centered insight and practical encouragement, Women Warriors equips women to stand firm in their identity in Christ and move forward unburdened—ready to fight for their future with confidence, freedom, and unwavering faith.
1004 I Became We and I Lost ME	addresses the quiet struggle many Christian women face after marriage, when loving and serving others can slowly overshadow personal identity. This session creates space to reflect on how roles as wives, mothers, leaders, and caregivers may blur who God uniquely created them to be. Attendees are encouraged to rediscover their individuality while honoring their commitments—learning how to expand, not abandon, their identity in Christ. Through biblical perspective and practical guidance, women will be equipped to find healthy balance, embrace personal growth, and remember that nurturing their God-given purpose strengthens every role they carry.
1005 The Good Mother	equips mothers with faith-centered wisdom and practical encouragement for parenting in an increasingly non-biblical culture. This session emphasizes establishing clear biblical standards in the home and building a strong spiritual foundation rooted in God's Word. Mothers will be encouraged to intentionally teach their children to stand firm in faith, resist compromise, and live out Christian values amid cultural pressure. Through truth, grace, and guidance, this session empowers mothers to raise children who know their identity in Christ and are prepared to live boldly and faithfully in the world.

Course Description

1006 Minding my Business is an empowering session designed to help Christian women take ownership of their financial future with wisdom, confidence, and faith. This session explores practical strategies for building wealth—including entrepreneurship, investing, budgeting, and multiple income streams—while honoring biblical principles of stewardship and integrity. Women will be encouraged to move beyond fear and limitation, recognizing financial growth as a tool for freedom, generosity, and Kingdom impact. Minding My Business equips women to be intentional, informed, and disciplined as they align financial decisions with God's purpose and walk boldly toward economic empowerment.

1007 Grieving & Still Growing offers compassionate encouragement for widowed Christian women navigating life after loss. This session creates a safe space to acknowledge grief while remaining anchored in faith and hope. Women will be reminded that even in sorrow, God still has purpose, healing, and life ahead. Through biblical truth and practical guidance, participants will explore moving forward with wisdom and confidence—embracing joy again, considering new relationships, and managing life's responsibilities. This session affirms that it is possible to honor the past while stepping faithfully into a future filled with grace, strength, and renewed purpose.

1008 The Women in the Mirror challenges Christian women to reflect honestly on how they see themselves and how their lives represent Christ to the world. This session explores the connection between inner identity and outward expression, examining how appearance, speech, attitude, and social media reflect values and character. Women will be encouraged to embrace who God created them to be, understanding that excellence, modesty, and integrity are expressions of confident faith—not limitations. This session inspires attendees to align their outward image with inward devotion, presenting their best selves with grace and authenticity.

1009 Healthy Heart, Healthy Spirit highlights the vital connection between a Christian woman's physical well-being and spiritual vitality. This session emphasizes caring for the body as God's temple through healthy habits, rest, and balanced living as acts of worship and stewardship. Women will be encouraged to view physical health as a tool that enables them to fully walk in their God-given calling. Equally important, the session addresses nurturing spiritual health through prayer, Scripture, and intentional time with God—reminding women that true wellness flows from both body and spirit. This session inspires women to pursue wholeness by honoring God from the inside out.
