#### **Never Too Old to Learn**

Mark 9 and Mark 10 – Jesus' love of children

Children – unafraid to ask questions!

Questions reveal that we are open to learning

Jesus' birth as a child – God is revealed in what children represent Openness and learning

"Disciple" – "to learn" (Student)

To follow Jesus is to be a life-long learner

Romans 12:2 – "be transformed by the renewal of your minds"

Example – John 21:18-19

Even when we're old and need assistance when we walk...

We never outgrow the call to follow; to learn; be a student



# **Romans 12:2 NRSV**

<sup>2</sup>Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God—what is good and acceptable and perfect.

# **Luke 2:12-14 NRSV**

<sup>18</sup> Very truly, I tell you, when you were younger, you used to fasten your own belt and to go wherever you wished.
