# Zechariah 8:1-8 NRSVUE

<sup>1</sup>The word of the LORD of hosts came to me, saying: <sup>2</sup>"Thus says the LORD of hosts: I am zealous for Zion with great zeal, and I am zealous for her with great wrath.

- <sup>3</sup>Thus says the LORD: I will return to Zion and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem; Jerusalem shall be called the faithful city, and the mountain of the LORD of hosts shall be called the holy mountain.
- <sup>4</sup>Thus says the LORD of hosts: Old men and old women shall again sit in the streets of Jerusalem, each with staff in hand because of their great age.
- <sup>5</sup> And the streets of the city shall be full of boys and girls playing in its streets.
- <sup>6</sup> Thus says the LORD of hosts: Even though it seems impossible to the remnant of this people in these days, should it also seem impossible to me, says the LORD of hosts?
- <sup>7</sup>Thus says the LORD of hosts: I will save my people from the east country and from the west country, <sup>8</sup> and I will bring them to live in Jerusalem. They shall be my people and I will be their God, in faithfulness and in righteousness."
