### Haggai 2:1-9, NRSVUE

<sup>1</sup>in the seventh month, on the twenty-first day of the month, the word of the LORD came by the prophet Haggai, saying: <sup>2</sup>“Speak now to Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and to the remnant of the people, and say: <sup>3</sup>**Who is left among you who saw this house in its former glory? How does it look to you now? Is it not in your sight as nothing?** <sup>4</sup>Yet now take courage, O Zerubbabel, says the LORD; take courage, O Joshua, son of Jehozadak, the high priest; take courage, all you people of the land, says the LORD; work, for I am with you, says the LORD of hosts, <sup>5</sup>according to the promise that I made you when you came out of Egypt. My spirit abides among you; do not fear. <sup>6</sup>**For thus says the LORD of hosts: Once again, in a little while, I will shake the heavens and the earth and the sea and the dry land,** <sup>7</sup>and I will shake all the nations, so that the treasure of all nations will come, and I will fill this house with splendor, says the LORD of hosts. <sup>8</sup>**The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, says the LORD of hosts.** <sup>9</sup>The latter splendor of this house shall be greater than the former, says the LORD of hosts, and in this place I will give prosperity, says the LORD of hosts.”
