⁶Now standing there were six stone water jars for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. ⁷Jesus said to them, "Fill the jars with water." **And they filled them up to the brim.** ⁸He said to them, "Now draw some out, and take it to the person in charge of the banquet." So they took it. ⁹**When the person in charge tasted the water that had become wine and did not know where it came from (though the servants who had drawn the water knew), that person called the bridegroom** ¹⁰and said to him, "Everyone serves the good wine first and then the inferior wine after the guests have become drunk. But you have kept the good wine until now."

John 5:7-9, NRSVUE

⁷The ill man answered him, "Sir, I have no one to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up, and while I am making my way someone else steps down ahead of me." ⁸**Jesus said to him, "Stand up, take your mat and walk."** ⁹At once the man was made well, and he took up his mat and began to walk. Now that day was a Sabbath.

John 6:5-9, 11, NRSVUE

⁵When he looked up and saw a large crowd coming toward him, Jesus said to Philip, "Where are we to buy bread for these people to eat?" ⁶He said this to test him, for he himself knew what he was going to do. ⁷**Philip answered him, "Two hundred denarii would not buy enough bread for each of them to get a little."** ⁸One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said to him, ⁹"There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish. But what are they among so many people?"

¹¹Then Jesus took the loaves, and when he had given thanks he distributed them to those who were seated; so also the fish, as much as they wanted.
