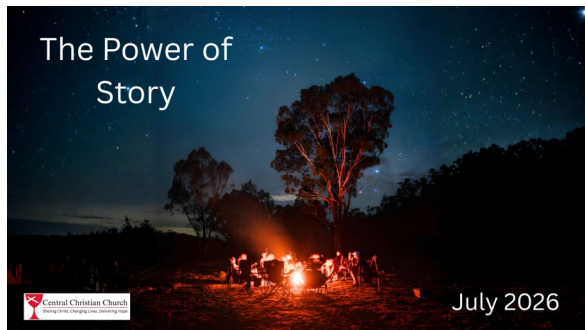




CONTEMPORARY WORSHIP

You can now sign up online –

- Go to the Universal Church Directories website (www.ucdir.com)
- Click on the red box on the right side of the homepage entitled "Photography Session Sign-Up"
- Enter the CCC church code (il487) & the CCC password (kdccc2026)
- Click "Enter"
- Click on the desired photography date
- Click on the Reserve Time button beside the desired photography appointment time
- Enter the appropriate information in all required fields (indicated by the asterisk)
- Click on the Schedule Appointment button at the bottom of the screen to reserve the photography appointment time in your family's name
- If you have more than six family members being photographed, please reserve two appointments consecutively (such as 6:12 and 6:24)
- Print the next screen to use as a reminder of your family's photography appointment
- Contact Kathleen in the office to change or cancel your photography appointment

Frequently asked questions:

- **Do I have to be a member** of Central to sign up?
- **Answer: No!** You do not need to be an official member to be part of this directory. If you enjoy attending and participating in church activities, we want you to be in it.
- **Can I bring my friend/sister/uncle/neighbor/etc.?**
- **Answer: Absolutely!** In fact, we're considering this an outreach! If you know someone not affiliated with Central, but who might like receiving a free household portrait, share our sign-up information with them! They will receive a FREE 8x10 portrait, and who knows? Maybe they'll visit Central and find the same warm, welcoming church family that you did.
- **Do I have to purchase anything?**
- **Answer: No, you don't.** You will have the opportunity to make a purchase, if you wish, but EVERY household that signs up for an appointment will receive a free 8x10 portrait.
- **What if I'm having difficulty** accessing the online sign up?
- **Answer:** We will have volunteers ready to help you sign up on Sundays July 12 & 19. Or you can call Kathleen in the office for assistance. Don't wait too long, though!

If you are moved during the service to confess your faith, or transfer your membership to Central, simply come up to the minister at the communion table **during the communion time**. Jonah 1:1-3, 2:1-2, 2:9-10 The Message Bible

1 ¹⁻² One day long ago, GOD's Word came to Jonah, Amittai's son: "Up on your feet and on your way to the big city of Nineveh! Preach to them. They're in a bad way and I can't ignore it any longer." ³ But Jonah got up and went the other direction to Tarshish, running away from GOD.

2 ¹⁻² "In trouble, deep trouble, I prayed to GOD.

He answered me.

From the belly of the grave I cried, 'Help!'

You heard my cry.

2 ⁹⁻¹⁰ But I'm worshiping you, GOD,

John 6:1-13 The Message Bible

1 Some time after this, Jesus crossed to the far shore of the Sea of Galilee (that is, the Sea of Tiberias), **2** and a great crowd of people followed him because they saw the signs he had performed by healing the sick. **3** Then Jesus went up on a mountainside and sat down with his disciples. **4** The Jewish Passover Festival was near. **5** When Jesus looked up and saw a great crowd coming toward him, he said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?" **6** He asked this only to test him, for he already had in mind what he was going to do. **7** Philip answered him, "It would take more than half a year's wages [a] to buy enough bread for each one to have a bite!" **8** Another of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up, **9** "Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?" **10** Jesus said, "Have the people sit down." There was plenty of grass in that place, and they sat down (about five thousand men were there). **11** Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish. **12** When they had all had enough to eat, he said to his disciples, "Gather the pieces that are left over. Let nothing be wasted." **13** So they gathered them and filled twelve baskets with the pieces of the five barley loaves left over by those who had eaten.
