Sermon Outline

"Un-Changed: One Family"

<u>Humankind was created to live in community. We were created for</u> fellowship: fellowship with God and fellowship with others.

1 Corinthians 1:9

God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

This Fellowship of Jesus Christ is like a Christian family, made up of a connected and unified people (we call it our church family). Specifically, they are connected and unified through a new birth experience, a common faith in Christ, and with the indwelling of the Holy Spirit.

First: Christian fellowship is a group of people connected together through the new birth experience. As children of God saved by grace through faith in Jesus Christ, we are brothers and sisters in Christ.

John 1:12-13

But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

Second: Christian fellowship is connected through a common faith on One Lord.

Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Third: Christian Fellowship is connected through God the Holy Spirit. God the Holy Spirit enables Christian Life by dwelling in individual believers and empowers them to live a life of faith.
