SERVE and FOLLOW

Luke 1:26-38 - Annunciation (Gabriel's visit to Mary)

We can all find ourselves in Mary's story:

- Analytical, logical types
- Those for whom God doesn't speak "loud & clear"
- Those who sometimes worry about tomorrow

Story is about God more than Mary (or any of us)

- How God first comes in peace
- How God goes to great lengths to *encourage*

God desires that we:

Serve (the greater will of God) Follow (believe that we can)

John the Baptist (Luke 3:7-18)

Doesn't call us to a different life

But calls us to live our lives different-ly!

Be more honest with ourselves Be more just, honest and fair in relationships with others Be more kind and generous in all things

²⁶ In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a town in Galilee called Nazareth, 27 to a virgin engaged to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. ²⁸ And he came to her and said, "Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with you." 29 But she was much perplexed by his words and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. 30 The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. 31 And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you will name him Jesus. 32 He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give to him the throne of his ancestor David. 33 He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end." 34 Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?" 35 The angel said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holy; he will be called Son of God. ³⁶ And now, your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son; and this is the sixth month for her who was said to be barren. ³⁷For nothing will be impossible with God." 38 Then Mary said, "Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be with me according to your word."
