SCRIPTURE LESSON

Psalm 49

¹ Hear this, all you peoples; give ear, all inhabitants of the world, ² both low and high, rich and poor together. ³ My mouth shall speak wisdom; the meditation of my heart shall be understanding. ⁴I will incline my ear to a proverb; I will solve my riddle to the music of the harp. ⁵Why should I fear in times of trouble, when the iniquity of my persecutors surrounds me, 6 those who trust in their wealth and boast of the abundance of their riches? ⁷Truly, no ransom avails for one's life; there is no price one can give to God for it. 8 For the ransom of life is costly and can never suffice, 9 that one should live on forever and never see the Pit. 10 When we look at the wise, they die; fool and dolt perish together and leave their wealth to others. ¹¹ Their graves are their homes forever, their dwelling places to all generations, though they named lands their own. ¹² Mortals cannot abide in their pomp; they are like the animals that perish. ¹³ Such is the fate of the foolhardy, the end of those who are pleased with their lot. *Selah* ¹⁴ Like sheep they are appointed for Sheol; Death shall be their shepherd; straight to the grave they descend, and their form shall waste away; Sheol shall be their home. 15 But God will ransom my soul from the power of Sheol, for he will receive me. *Selah* ¹⁶ Do not be afraid when some become rich, when the wealth of their houses increases. ¹⁷ For when they die they will carry nothing away; their wealth will not go down after them. ¹⁸ Though in their lifetime they count themselves happy—for you are praised when you do well for yourself -19 they will go to the company of their ancestors, who will never again see the light. ²⁰ Mortals cannot abide in their pomp; they are like the animals that perish.

Luke 12:13-21

¹³ Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the family inheritance with me." ¹⁴ But he said to him, "Friend, who set me to be a judge or arbitrator over you?" ¹⁵ And he said to them, "Take care!
