## Deuteronomy 13:6-11

### Launch

This week we learned that God's purpose for us is to be different than the world. The world is filled with idolatry and if we are not careful, we can fall into it without even knowing. Idolatry is more than just worshipping a statue, it is something that is immoral and takes our focus away from God. God demands that we turn from idol worship of any kind and that we need to remember God and the mission He has given us, to be different than the world.

### Explore

#### Read the passage

Read through Deuteronomy 13:1-18.

*After reading this, how do you think God values human life? How should we interpret hard passages like this that involve violence?*

### Apply
