Deuteronomy 22:5-11

Launch

This past weekend we learned that **God's purpose means maintaining God's boundaries.** In Deuteronomy 22, Moses lays out boundaries that the Israelites are to follow in order to fulfill their purpose. These verses describe physical realities but behind these physical realities are spiritual ones. We talked about three different boundaries, including: Gender boundaries, Moral boundaries, and Relational boundaries. In a broken world filled with broken boundaries, we must maintain the ones God has laid out through His word.
