

# Deuteronomy Twenty Three

## Deuteronomy 23:9-14

### Launch

This past weekend we learned that **God's community needs daily heart cleaning**. In Deuteronomy 23, we learned that when Israel would go to war it was viewed as a Holy ceremony. Moses declared that the camp was to be Holy as the Lord was moving among them. Likewise, we need to be cleaning our hearts daily as God still moves among us today.

### Explore

### Apply

*Read Deuteronomy 23:15-24. What can these examples teach us about what it means to love our neighbors as Christians?*
