

# Deuteronomy Twenty Four

## Deuteronomy 24:10-15

### Launch

This past weekend we learned that **God's purpose means treating others with dignity.** The community of God is called to reflect the character of God. When the people of God live according to the law, they have the opportunity to reveal God to the world. God's purpose of treating others with dignity includes paying fair wages, not taking collateral for a loan, and trusting God with our emotions.
