

# Deuteronomy Twenty Seven

## Deuteronomy 27:1-13

### Launch

This past weekend we learned that **God's purpose means stepping out of the wilderness.** There comes a time when what you have been preparing for and practicing for finally comes and it's time to do the thing. For the Israelites it was stepping out of the wilderness where they have been wandering and entering into the Promised Land and fulfilling being the people of God.
