Launch

This past weekend we learned that **God's purpose is trusting God when you don't have the answers.** We get frustrated and confused at times in our faith walks because something happens that doesn't seem to be like something that is in God's plan for us. We may question our faith or even God's understanding. However, we must trust in God's plan for us and that withholding understanding may actually be in His plan for us.. Moses tells us that when we don't have the answers, trusting in God's character is enough.
