The plot to kill both Jesus and Lazarus.

Now a great many of the Jews knew He was there; and they came, not for Jesus' sake only, but they might also see Lazarus, whom He had raised from the dead. But the chief priests plotted to put ***Lazarus*** to death also, because ***on account of him many of the Jews went away and believed in Jesus.***+

The chief priests plotted to put Lazarus to death also: The chief priests were mostly Sadducees, and the Sadducees didn't believe in the resurrection. Lazarus was a living example of life after death, and having him around was an embarrassment to their theological system. For them, there was only one solution to this embarrassing problem – to put Lazarus to death also.

On account of him many of the Jews went away and believed in Jesus: This made the problem of the chief priests worse. ***The miracle of raising Lazarus from the dead drew many people to Jesus.*** Therefore, in the opinion of these religious leaders, Lazarus also had to be stopped.
