## MUSIC NOTES:

Fanny Hensel (née Mendelssohn) was the older sister of Felix, but every bit as fine a composer as he (sometimes he published her compositions under his name so they would be available to the public without her being subjected to public scrutiny — 19th-century German conventions of women being wives, mothers, and homemakers and not career women).

Fanny and Felix agreed that each would compose one of the marches for her wedding. Unfortunately, Felix had a carriage accident in London, and wrote a letter apologizing for missing her wedding in Berlin, and failed to include in the letter the “March in A Major” he had written (the opening of his organ Sonata in A). So the night before her wedding she wrote the other march.

Today we hear both of the marches (processional and recessional) Fanny composed for her own wedding. Incidentally, her husband, Wilhelm Hensel, was the court painter at Berlin, and he had no problem at all with her having a career as a composer, and being known as a composer; this was only an issue for her brother and father!
