MUSIC NOTES:

Two German composers set the chorale for the Lord's Prayer. Both of Bach's arrangements place the tune on top, with an imitative accompaniment. The first, from the *Orgelbuchlein*, is drawn from the first phrase of the tune; the second, from the *Clavierbung III*, is a smooth scale ascending and descending, just as our prayers ascend to God and blessings descend to us.

Mendelssohn was a Jewish convert to the Lutheran church, subsequently married to a Calvinist. The Calvinist *Geneva Psalter* included the Lord's Prayer and Ten Commandments along with all 150 Psalms for congregational singing, and all of these were adopted by the Lutherans. His sixth sonata states the "Lord's Prayer" chorale, which is followed by four variations, of which the last is a toccata with the hymn tune in the pedals. There is also a fugue based on the first phrase of the hymn, but this is not included in today's postlude.
