NOA (No One Alone) is a 501(c)(3) Non Profit that provides shelter and support services to victims of domestic violence and their children in Lumpkin and Dawson counties.

All Services are free and confidential.

A trained advocate will always answer to provide you with information.

NOA provides emergency shelter, legal advocacy and court support, case management, support groups, trauma counseling, child advocacy, life skills, parenting classes and community outreach programs to this vulnerable population.

In 2022, NOA served 2,086 clients and received 3,463 crisis calls and provided shelter to 128 women/men/children!
