Core: Read Matthew 26:17-29

1. What is the Feast of Unleavened Bread? Why is it called that?
2. What does Jesus' desire to celebrate the passover with His disciples tell us about Jesus and His disciples?
3. How would you describe Jesus' demeanor in this passage? What does Jesus' control over the situation tell you about Jesus and the circumstances?

4. In verse 20 Jesus is described as reclining at the table with His disciples. How would you describe this setting? Was it formal, informal, comfortable or uncomfortable?

5. How does Jesus' announcement that one of His disciples would betray Him fit into the scene in verses 17-20?

6. How do the disciples respond to Jesus' announcement? What, if anything, should we learn from their response? Have you ever asked yourself if you have betrayed Jesus?

7. Part of the Lord's Supper is examining oneself. Are you ever tempted to start examining others instead of yourself? How should we examine ourselves when preparing to take the Lord's Supper?

8. How does Jesus give new meaning to the Passover celebration when instituting the Lord's Supper?

9. What does the Lord's Supper mean to you?
