3. Would you describe yourself as living a “simple” life? What do you mean? What do you think Paul meant when he described his lifestyle as simplistic?
4. Compare and contrast “worldly wisdom” with the “grace of God.”

5. What do you make of Paul's change of plans in verses 15-20? Can you think of a time in your life when your plans changed (either by choice or by circumstance) and God worked through that change of plans anyway? What was the key to being used by God or growing your relationship with God during that time?

6. How is Jesus the fulfillment of all of God's promises?

7. What does it mean that we are "sealed" by God? How does He do that? Is there a difference between His anointing and His sealing? How so?

8. How is the Holy Spirit a down payment or guarantee?

9. How can we work with others for their joy?
