4. Why are these discipling relationships so important?

5. Is it significant that Paul tells Timothy to remain in Ephesus? Why? What should take away from Paul's command to Timothy?
6. How is it that some people get caught up in teachings that distract from true faith in Jesus?
7. What does it mean that the "aim of our charge is love?"
8. How would you define a "pure heart," a "good conscience," and a "sincere faith?"
9. What is the law good for and why is that important for us?
10. What is the relationship between God's law and God's grace?
