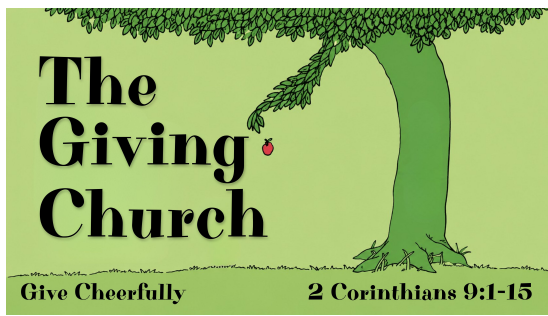




Give Cheerfully Small Group Questions 2 Corinthians 9:1-15 July 19

Core: Read 2 Corinthians 9:1-15

1. What does Paul boast to other churches about the the church in Corinth? If you were going to boast about Wallula to other churches, what would you say?
2. What warning does Paul give to the church about his boasting? What steps do we need to take to make sure your boasting isn't in vain?
3. Why was it so important to Paul that the Corinthians prepare to give ahead of time? What should we learn from this principle?
4. What do you think the principle of the sower in verse 6 teaches? Is this a financial principle? A spiritual principle? Some other kind of principle?

5. What commands are handed down concerning giving in vers 7? Why does God love a cheerful giver?
6. What promises does God make concerning those who give cheerfully in verses 8-11?
7. What was the most important benefit that would arise from the collection for the Jerusalem church? What should be the results of our giving according to verse 12-14?
8. Why is the gift described as “indescribable” in 2 Corinthians 9:15?
9. How does understanding Jesus as God’s indescribable gift impact your daily life and faith journey? In what ways can we express gratitude for God’s gift in your personal and community life?
