4. If you had to summarize David's description of God's voice, what would you say? What significance does this have for understanding the nature and power of God/
5. Why is God described as being over many waters?

6. When have you experienced the power of God in your life? How did that experience affect your understanding of Him?
  
7. In today's world, where do you see or hear the "voice of God" as described in this Psalm?
  
8. How should Psalm 29 influence your approach to public, communal worship?
  
9. What do you think it means that God "sits enthroned over the flood?" How does this fact apply to personal challenges you might face?
  
10. How might the peace of God as described in verse 11 differ from the world's understanding of peace? What about the strength God provides? Is it different from the strength the world expects?
