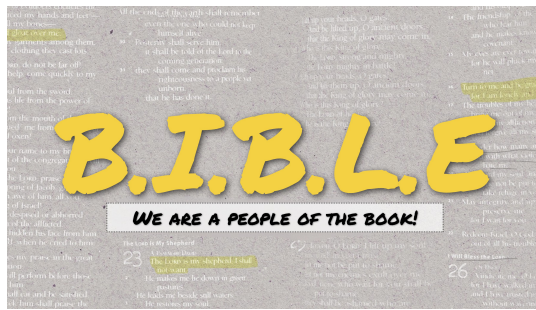




# I Stand Alone on the Word of God

## Core: Read Colossians 3:15-17

1. Paul often says "let this or that be," what do you think is intended by "let the peace of Christ rule in your heart?"
2. How is the peace of Christ connected to our hearts? What does His peace ruling in our hearts mean? What is the connection between the peace of Christ and the body of Christ?
3. How does peace and thanksgiving go together?
4. Is there a connection between the peace of Christ and the word of Christ?

5. What does it look like for the word of Christ to dwell richly in you?
6. Ephesians 5:19 connects singing psalms and hymns to being filled with the Spirit. How do you think the Holy Spirit and the word of Christ are connected?
7. How does communal worship—such as teaching, admonishing, and singing together—help build God's word into our lives?
8. According to verse 17, what areas of our life should be influenced by Jesus?
9. What is one task or practical area of your life this week where it might be difficult to live out this command to do everything in the name of Jesus?
10. How does the command to give thanks to God the Father through Jesus in every area of your life change the way you view everyday tasks and activities?
