Core: Read 1 Timothy 1:12-20

1. Where does Paul contend he gets the strength to serve in ministry?
2. How does Paul describe himself when he was appointed to the service of Jesus? What enabled him to begin serving Jesus?
3. What does it mean that Paul describes himself as the "foremost" of sinners?
4. How can our experience with Jesus' grace and mercy help others to experience that same mercy?

5. How does this passage encourage you to be more merciful? What is challenging to you in regards to showing mercy to others?
6. What stands out to you as you read verse 17? According to this passage what can we do to give glory to God?
7. How is Timothy to engage in the “good warfare?” What does that look like for us today?
8. How have some people made a shipwreck of their faith? What do we need to be on the lookout for to avoid this result?
9. What, if anything, should we learn about church discipline or even our own relationships from verse 20? What do you think it means that Paul handed these guys over to Satan? Is there ever a reason we should act in a similar way? Why? Why not?
