Core: Read 2 Corinthians 4:1-6

3. Have you ever been discouraged while serving Jesus? How is Paul able to avoid this feeling?
4. What do you think qualifies as "disgraceful, underhanded ways?" What does it look like to renounce such actions?

5. What do you think tampering with God's word looks like? Can you offer any examples? Why is this so dangerous?

6. What are some ways the enemy keeps people from seeing the gospel? How should we react to this blindness in the world?

7. At Wallula, we talk about transforming the casual. How often do you pray for folks taking spiritual matters casually to have their eyes opened to the truth?

8. In what ways can people be guilty of proclaiming themselves instead of Jesus?

9. Where must the light of Jesus shine first before it can shine in the world? How do we make sure our hearts are "shined up?"
