### **Prayer of Illumination**

**Scripture Reading** *Matthew 21:1-11*

**21** When they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage at the Mount of Olives, Jesus then sent two disciples, <sup>2</sup>telling them, "Go into the village ahead of you. At once you will find a donkey tied there with her colt. Untie them and bring them to me. <sup>3</sup>If anyone says anything to you, say that the Lord needs them, and he will send them at once."

<sup>4</sup>This took place so that what was spoken through the prophet might be fulfilled:

<sup>5</sup>Tell Daughter Zion, "See, your King is coming to you,  
gentle, and mounted on a donkey, and on a colt,  
the foal of a donkey."

<sup>6</sup>The disciples went and did just as Jesus directed them. <sup>7</sup>They brought the donkey and the colt; then they laid their clothes on them, and he sat on them. <sup>8</sup>A very large crowd spread their clothes on the road;

others were cutting branches from the trees and spreading them on the road. <sup>9</sup> Then the crowds who went ahead of him and those who followed shouted:

**Hosanna** to the Son of David!  
**Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!**  
**Hosanna** in the highest heaven!

<sup>10</sup>When he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was in an uproar, saying, “Who is this?” <sup>11</sup>**The crowds were saying, “This is the prophet Jesus from Nazareth in Galilee.”**
