Scripture Reading 1 John 5:14-21

¹⁴ This is the confidence we have before him; if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. ¹⁵ And if we know that he hears us whatever we ask, we know that we4 have what we have asked of him.

¹⁶ If anyone sees a fellow believer committing a sin that doesn't lead to death, he should ask, and God will give life to him—to those who commit sin that doesn't lead to death. There is sin that leads to death. I am not saying he should pray about that. ¹⁷ All unrighteousness is sin, and there is sin that doesn't lead to

death.

¹⁸ We know that everyone who has been born of God does not sin, but the one who is born of God keeps him, and the evil one does not touch him. ¹⁹ We know that we are of God, and the whole world is under the sway of the evil one. ²⁰ And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding so that we may know the true one.
