

PASTOR'S PONDERING

There's an old saying, "If you love something, set it free." Sometimes, it's about a wild animal that never belonged behind closed doors. But as anyone who's seen a stampede knows, not everything gets better just because you take off the restraints. Freedom, without purpose or direction, can lead to chaos. Proverbs 29:18 reads, "Where there is no prophetic vision the people cast off restraint." When there isn't a clear, shared vision, people scatter and a community loses its shape and purpose.

Churches face the same challenge. Without a guiding vision, we lose track of what we're here to do. Fortunately, we haven't been left guessing. In the opening chapter of Acts, as Jesus prepares to ascend, he leaves the disciples with a calling: "You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." (Acts 1:8) This calling has not died; this is who we are, and this is our mission.

But what does it mean to be a witness for Jesus? The word "witness" can mean plenty of things. It can be as passive as seeing something happen and moving on, or as active as testifying in court. Sometimes, it means going public with what you've seen, even when it's uncomfortable. What does witness mean to you, when you think about Jesus? How are your actions giving meaning to that word?

At the heart of all this, there's another promise. Before Jesus tells his friends to be witnesses, he tells them they won't do it alone. "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you," He says. The story of the church is not just about what we do for God, but what God does through us. That same Spirit lives in you. If you've ever thought, "I'm not sure I can serve, or talk about faith, or contribute in a meaningful way," remember, the power to witness and serve doesn't come from us alone. We are vessels, and God's Spirit is at work within us, making ordinary acts precious.

Our sense of mission, our calling to witness, and the courage to say yes, are things that unite us. That's why the continued support for our church's ministries matters so deeply. I am grateful for every gift, every pledge, every act of stewardship that has allowed our ministry to continue. Your generosity has truly sustained not just budgets, but lives and witness far beyond these walls.

Looking ahead to 2026, I ask you to prayerfully consider making a pledge commitment to support our church's mission and ministry.
