Kingdom Come
Your Will Be Done
Mat 6:10b

Sunday July 27	Reading: Matthew 6:9-13 Prayer: Rejoice, the Lord is King! And our heavenly, sovereign Father is pursuing His purpose to bring heaven and earth all together under the loving reign of Jesus.
Monday July 28	Reading: Leviticus 27-Numbers 1 Prayer: Pray for Saleem and Joy as they minister and plant churches in North Africa. Pray for the many young Christians and seekers that Saleem and Joy meet with as they learn to live out their faith in a society and culture that is against Christianity. Pray specifically for <i>Anis</i> (who attended their Easter service), <i>Hamid</i> (whose family is keeping him from fellowship), <i>Zaina</i> (to come to know Jesus through reading her Bible), <i>Akram</i> (who struggles with depression), and <i>Souhail</i> (who wrestles with doubt). Pray that Joy and Saleem's ministry team in North Africa would grow and that God would raise up a team of people to long-term service there in the near future.
Tuesday July 29	Reading: Numbers 2-3 Prayer: Repent of the places where we disapprove of His will, or even reject it. Bring your struggle before Him and ask for grace to agree in prayer with Jesus: "Yet not as I will, but as you will."
