Sunday July 20	Reading: Matthew 6:9-13 Prayer: Praise the King who loves us and who delights to give us His Kingdom to His little flock (Lk 12:32).
Monday July 21	Reading: Leviticus 23-24 Prayer: Pray for Vijay Meesala (and his wife Abigail and four children) as he leads Reach All Nations , a ministry committed to training national missionaries and planting indigenous churches in India. Pray for a Christian witness to the over 2000 unreached people groups in India. Pray for Vijay's local church whose theme this year is "Becoming Faithful Disciples of Jesus."
