Matthew 5:7

Sunday Mar 30	Reading: Matthew 5:1-10 Prayer: Give thanks that the first thing we see when God shows us His glory is His mercy. Praise Him for His glorious mercy!
Monday Mar 31	Reading: Genesis 49-50 Prayer: Pray also for Dr. Juvenal Musavuli and his wife Sifa .
