<b>Sunday</b> May 11	<b>Reading:</b> Matthew 5:21-26 <b>Prayer:</b> Give thanks that God's anger never gets out of control but is always pure and redemptive. His anger at sin led Him to provide a solution so that we could be redeemed through Jesus.
<b>Monday</b> May 12	<b>Reading:</b> Exodus 23-24 <b>Prayer:</b> Pray for <b>Jorum and Evah Mugari</b> , our newest missionaries who serve with <b>Mission to the World</b> in their native <b>Zimbabwe</b> .
