Kingdom Prayer

Matthew 6:5-8

Sunday July 6	Reading: Matthew 6:5-8 Prayer: Praise our Heavenly Father who knows what we need and graciously and abundantly provides everything for our good and for His good purposes.
Monday July 7	Reading: Leviticus 15-16 Prayer: Pray for Ben Spivey and his wife Kirstin and their family. After seven years with Reformed University Fellowship at Liberty , the Spiveys will begin working toward planting an RUF in London, the first in the UK. Pray for wisdom for Ben as he raises support, makes transitions, and seeks to serve God in a new setting. Pray, too, for the transition for RUF in Lynchburg. Pray for wisdom for new leadership and that students would continue to grow to more fully understand the love, peace, and presence of their Heavenly Father and live boldly for Him.
Tuesday July 8	Reading: Leviticus 117-18 Prayer: Ask God to reveal to you the masks you wear and the ways that you seek the approval of others. Repent, and rejoice in His forgiveness!

Thursday July 10	Reading: John 16 Prayer: Pray for God to lead you to a deeper and more intimate life and practice of prayer.
Friday July 11	Reading: John 17 Prayer: Pray for Weekly Religious Education that more workers and students will join to teach and learn about God and spread the Gospel.
Saturday July 12	Reading: Catch up on your reading for the week. Prayer: Pray that our older saints will have a desire to continue “to bear fruit in old age” and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, steadfastness and gentleness,” not “lacking in zeal but fervent in spirit, serving the Lord.” (Ps. 92:14; I Tim. 6:11; Rom. 12:11)
