Sunday Sep 15	Reading: John 18:1-18; 2 Chronicles 26; Psalm 83 Prayer: Give thanks that God is with us, through the valleys, through the fire, through the difficulties, in order to care for us and keep us.
Monday Sep 16	Reading: John 18:19-38; 2 Chronicles 27-28; Psalm 84 Prayer: Pray for Weekday Religious Education (WRE) and its ministry in Waynesboro and Augusta County. Pray for the Gospel to be preached boldly to hundreds of children, many of whom do not attend local churches. Pray for the WRE teachers (including our very own Linda Dickerson , who works at Clymore Elementary) to grow in grace, to be full of energy and creativity, and to faithfully bless children with the abundant love of Christ. Pray that the Lord will use the ministry of WRE to transform the lives of children and families in our communities.
Tuesday Sep 17	Reading: John 18:38-19:16; 2 Chronicles 29; Psalm 85 Prayer: Repent of the ways we take God's presence with us for granted, failing to follow Him but instead imagining He follows us.
