The Good News of the Gospel
Repentance Is Good; Revelation 2:1-7

Sunday July 28	Reading: 1 Corinthians 14:26-40; 2 Kings 9; Jonah 4 Prayer: Praise the Lord who gathers His repenting people to bless us with eternal life with Him!
Monday July 29	Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:1-34; 2 Kings 10; Micah 1 Prayer: Pray for Kiran Boddu , one of Tab's newest missionaries. Kiran leads New Life Initiative in India and partners with Equipping Leaders International . NLI and ELI are currently partnered together to plant presbyteries and churches in South India, North India, and Nepal. Pray that Christ would be exalted throughout the nation of India.
