The Good News of the Gospel
Justice Is Good; Revelation 15:3-4

Sunday May 12	Reading: Acts 21:1-36; Judges 16; Psalm 42 Prayer: Give thanks that Jesus "will not grow faint or be discouraged till he has established justice in the earth" (Is 42:4). His righteous Kingdom will not fail to make straight what is crooked and so that justice will prevail forever.
Monday May 13	Reading: Acts 21:37-22:29; Judges 17-18; Psalm 43 Prayer: Pray for Willis Weatherford , the campus minister with RUF at Washington & Lee University . Pray, too, for his wife Mary and three kids--Judah, Juniper, and James. Pray for energy and enthusiasm and for many opportunities to connect with students and to walk with them as they grow in their faith. Pray for peace and perseverance for students as they wrap up the semester and take exams. Pray for Willis and his leadership team to be able to rest and plan well this summer and for RUF students to be a blessing to families and home churches throughout the summer.
Tuesday May 14	Reading: Acts 22:30-23:22; Judges 19; Psalm 44 Prayer: Ask for grace to do justice, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with God on His mission to establish justice. Ask forgiveness for our own injustices. Go to Him to find strength to forgive those who have been unjust to us.
