Sunday Jan 7	Reading: Luke 8:26-56; Genesis 13:1-14:24; Psalm 7 Prayer: Praise the Lord for your birthright! He has made you His own child and given you all of the rights of His Kingdom, including the power to become more like Him.
Monday Jan 8	Reading: Luke 9:1-27; Genesis 15; Psalm 8 Prayer: Pray for Heath and Jane McLaughen who minister with RUF at Virginia Tech . Pray for continued enthusiasm for them as they share the Gospel and their lives with students. Pray for excitement and energy and excellent planning as the new semester begins.
