Sunday Feb 11	Reading: Hebrews 8; Exodus 5:1-6:27; Proverbs 1 Prayer: Praise God that we have a place to bring our guilt and shame and failure. Give thanks that Jesus receives us and makes us holy, and transforms us into people who no longer have to hide or lie about our need for grace.
