Sunday Feb 25	Reading: Matthew 6:1-18; Exodus 33:1-34:35; Proverbs 15 Prayer: Thank the Lord for His grace to you--His unmerited and unconditional kindness and forgiveness extended to us that unites us to Jesus and makes us His saints, His holy ones. Exhort yourself to believe this and rejoice in it!
Monday Feb 26	Reading: Matthew 6:19-34; Exodus 35:1-36:38; Proverbs 16 Prayer: Jeff Borden works with SAGE International where he serves as Curriculum Director and teacher. He continues to have opportunities to work with seminaries in Zimbabwe, Cameroon, and a new work in Tanzania. Pray that Jeff's ministry would continue to bear much fruit in the lives of many and would positively impact the African church!
