Sunday Oct 29	Reading: Philemon 1:1-25; Jeremiah 19-20; Psalm 128 Prayer: Give thanks to God for the grace He provides to be more than conquerors (when we win) and more than sufferers (when we lose).
Monday Oct 30	Reading: James 1; Jeremiah 21-22; Psalm 129 Prayer: Pray for Weekday Religious Education (WRE) and its ministry in Waynesboro and Augusta County. Pray for the Gospel to be preached boldly to hundreds of children, many of whom do not attend local churches.
