Sunday Nov 19	Reading: 1 Peter 2; Jeremiah 33-34; Psalm 135 Prayer: Give thanks to the One who joyful endured the cross and scorned its shame because He loves us and it makes Him happy to bless us.
Monday Nov 20	Reading: 1 Peter 3; Jeremiah 35-36; Psalm 136 Prayer: Pray for UVA's RUF campus minister, Josiah Carey and his wife Kelley and children Audra and Ames. Pray that they would know and faithfully proclaim Christ crucified and risen, and that His Spirit would be at work in RUF at the University of Virginia . Pray also for the entire RUF staff team to be faithful servants as they connect with students, serve them, and love them well. Pray that RUF students would grow in their faith, connect with local churches, and be a blessing to the UVA and Charlottesville communities. Pray that the Gospel would bear much fruit in their lives.
