Failure and Restoration

John 21:1-22

Sunday Feb. 12	Reading: Hebrews 9:1-22; Exodus 6:28-8:32; Proverbs 2 Prayer: Lord, help me to see my own sin with clear eyes and enable me to confess my sins and claim the mercies purchased for me by Christ at the cross. Keep me from justifying, blame-shifting, minimizing, or excusing my failures.
Monday Feb. 13	Reading: Hebrews 9:23-10:18; Exodus 9:1-10:29; Proverbs 3 Prayer: Pray for Willis Weatherford , the new campus minister with RUF at Washington & Lee University . Pray, too, for his wife Mary and three kids--Judah, Juniper, and James. Pray for energy and enthusiasm as Willis and his family continue their ministry at W&L. Pray for meaningful relationships with students, and that the students at W&L would grow in their faith and see God's goodness in all circumstances. Pray for a continued faithful witness at Washington & Lee.
Tuesday Feb. 14	Reading: Hebrews 10:19-39; Exodus 11:1-12:51; Proverbs 4 Prayer: Lord, grant us protection from the accusations of the enemy. Though he prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking to devour us, give us strength so that we may resist him and our faith may not fail.
