Sunday Mar. 19	Reading: Matthew 18:21-35; Numbers 7-8; Ecclesiastes 6 Prayer: That God would reveal to us the hardness of our hearts that we might repent.
Monday Mar. 20	Reading: Matthew 19:1-15; Numbers 9-10; Ecclesiastes 7 Prayer: Pray for Joy and Saleem as they minister and plant churches in North Africa. Pray for continued wisdom and perseverance as they meet with new contacts, and pray for even more contacts that hunger and thirst for righteousness.
