Sunday Feb 4	Scripture: Matthew 23:13-39, Psalm 28:1-9, Proverbs 7:1-5 Prayer: Listen to (and take to heart) God's comforting words to you: I am exceedingly jealous for Jerusalem and for Zion....I have returned to Jerusalem with mercy...and the Lord will again comfort Zion and again choose Jerusalem" (Zech 1:14-17).
Monday Feb 5	Scripture: Matthew 24:1-28, Psalm 29:1-11, Proverbs 7:6-23 Prayer: Learn to lament. Start your prayer with "O LORD of hosts, how long..." and then complete the sentence. Repeat as often as necessary.
Tuesday Feb 6	Scripture: Matthew 24:29-51, Psalm 30:1-12, Proverbs 7:24-27 Prayer: Rejoice that God has promised to cast down the horns of those who oppose Him and His Kingdom. Rejoice that a Day is coming when Satan, sin, and death will be no more!
Wednesday Feb 7	Scripture: Matthew 25:1-30, Psalm 31:1-8, Proverbs 8:1-11 Prayer: Pray for the ministry that reached Middle River Jail and they will continue to share the Gospel boldly.
