Sunday Feb 7	Scripture: Leviticus 22-23 Prayer: Give thanks for Tabernacle and for the church around the world. Pray that the Gospel would continue to grow us in maturity and in number, and that God would continue to multiply us.
Monday Feb 8	Scripture: Leviticus 24-25 Prayer: Confess your shame over the Gospel, and ask for greater boldness to share the truth that Jesus died on a cross and rose from the dead to make us right with God.
Tuesday Feb 9	Scripture: Leviticus 26-27 Prayer: Believe the Gospel today. By faith in Jesus, you are approved, accepted, and included. You didn't do anything to deserve these blessings, so don't act or think like God owes you anything. Live today as a recipient of His mercy, and pass it along to those around you.
Wednesday Feb 10	Scripture: Numbers 1-2 Prayer: Pray for our local schools as they continue to get back on schedule from the snow storm.
